Mrs. Davis has also intimated to me your arrival at London. She along with her husband will be spiritually benefited also by your presence there. I am happy that your condition is good. I feel that is expanding within you. In other words, inner sphere is being widened to touch the Infinite. You have written in your letter that you had feeling of shower of energy or vibrations. That is the descent of His grace. You have written a very good sentence in your letter in the context of going to Belgium that all this is going on like water to the river. It is the condition where we do not form the impression of thoughts and the actions. By transmission the level of emptiness improves and the man is cleaned off. Emptiness is really a part of Reality. Then you write, ".....then I suppose, will come the level where emptiness and fullness have no meaning."

I am exceedingly happy to see the sentence from you and I appreciated it very much. It is a fact beyond doubt the Ultimate Reality, so to say.

As far as I think, all of us will have to come consciously or unconsciously to the spiritual side if we want to maintain peace in us. The world is full of tumult and disorder that everybody knows. We have come not to destroy the creation but to make it in perfect order. I call a man perfect if both sides are perfect, I mean to say that this world where we live and other world

where we have to go. Herr Robert Koch had written to me that his wife Mrs. Ruth would be coming to India and stay with me in the month of December. As the month of December is far off so, I have not yet enquired about her arrival. At the time of his departure he also said that his wife would come in December 1970 and he in 1971. I also received a letter from Mrs. Davis saying that she would come to India in the first week of January 1971 and she wants me to be with her in Madras.

I had no programme of South this year, but Dr. K C Varadachari of Tirupati wants me at Tirupati to attend the third seminar of the Research Institute, which was going to be held on 11<sup>th</sup> October 1970. I have written to him to have it in the first week of November 1970, if he want my presence, because now a days I am very weak on account of work doing in low blood pressure. It will take about a month to recoup my health. I shall go to Tirupati for about a week or so if the date of the seminar is changed. I am happy that you are again coming to India and will stay with me. I will call here Shri P. Rajagopalachari also. I have finished construction of the four rooms kept apart for our European associates. You will find them just as Europeans like. Now, you will not feel trouble at all, when you fix the date I will then be in a position to decide to meet you again in Madras.

I celebrate the birthday of my Master which falls on January 31, 1971. So from 18<sup>th</sup> of January to 5<sup>th</sup> of February 1971 I will not be able to move out from Shahjahanpur. So many members of the mission take part in it.

My dear Poray,

Thanks to receive your affectionate letter. My health has begun to improve since the commencement of winter. I work with rest, still the work is heavier, and I want more and more work, because I am for this purpose.

I am happy that yourself, Mr. and Mrs. Davis are coming here. The arrangement of bedding is here. If any of you need more it will be available here. I will be very happy if all of you participate in the birthday function of our Master. The dates of the celebration of the functions are 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> of January 1971 and 1<sup>st</sup> February 1971. I have got constructed four rooms with attached bathrooms. So you will find no difficulty. About my going to Madras I will like to do what you wish provided some other important work does not want me at Shahajahanpur.

Here in India too we have a particular sect who observes silence. But the observance is simply physical and has nothing to do with inner silence. You are perfectly right that there are different levels of silence. Physical silence does not give the experience of those levels. Inner silence is of course a spiritual condition, which is silence in silence. Inner silence even grows lighter and lighter as we proceed on. There comes a time when even inner silence is lost. When it comes, we feel in and out or in other words all in silence. I have a mind to give provisional permission to Mrs. Davis and she has agreed to work for the Mission. I am going to take up your case shortly for your further approach.

I am replying your letter dated 22/11/1971 with much delay. When I read your letter I found that I have now begun to produce saints in the West by the grace of the Master. It is a fact without doubt that you are connected with me. The silver thread you have noticed shows the purity of the connections. Afterwards the thread turned into light and that is a step forward.

You have correctly felt that when you transmit anybody you get something. The power descends even when you are in a mood to transmit others. It is for the benefit of the abhyasis. A major part of it falls in the share of the teacher and so the teacher is doubly benefited. When you speak and utter some words a sort of vacuum is created and that gap is filled with the spiritual energy, which comes from within. The basis of words is thought. If thoughts are pure, words will also be pure and effective.

During deep sleep called *Sushupti* in Sanskrit, a man becomes benumbed catching energy from all angles necessary for deep sleep. When energy becomes dull, memory is lost. If memory is there, the man will not come to the state of *Sushupti* because the second thing will not allow him to go to the deep sleep disturbing all the while.

Here, in India when we open any centre of the Mission, we name as Shri Ram Chandra Mission Centre or if it is a branch Shri Ram Chandra Mission Branch. If theosophist has any objection to it you may have "Sahaj Marg Branch".

I am reaching Madras on 11<sup>th</sup> February. I may be there by the end of February. Programme will be finalised in Madras in consultation with Mr. P. My Dear Andre Poray,

Received your letter dated 19/04/76. The 'Rishis' of yore in India, use to take science when they felt that their super conscious state was in working order and proper adjustment of the faculty was there. It means that they took all these factors for use in the work of realization. Every thing is set right and the result is correct. Double thinking does not work. I give you a few instances. There was a Rishi named Bharadwaj. He was well up in physics and wrote even the weight of prominent stars. For aeroplane, he has written that mercury can be used as fuel. Another Rishi Chanakya of the medieval age has also written scientific and medical books and they are available but their language Sanskrit is very hard. These are the examples which prove that science is not the prominent

part of Realisation. If you keep a diamond before me on one side of the scale and a grain of Spirituality on the other side, I would prefer the Grain of Spirituality than the diamond.

This is the natural trend of the mind of the Indians from bygone ages.

The method we adopt is Scientific and it takes you even beyond matter. When you were at Shahjahanpur I introduced you to the collector of this place. There was some spiritual talk and during that discourse you said that "we are tired of materialism and we are coming to the spiritual side, while India is going towards matter."

Up to certain level of improvement, science can explain so many things. When we go beyond the matter, science is silent. Our method is Scientific and it ends when we begin at the threshold of Divinity. That is to say we peep from behind and get the result onwards. The whole of the system is vacuumised. (I have cleared this point in my book 'Efficacy of Raj Yoga'). When you meditate a sort of vacuum is created and the Divinity comes to fill the surface. It comes although uninvited and still you get something and that something is worthwhile having. If a man does not want to improve spiritually, he should have the idea at least in his mind of a baby who loves mother and father both. He gets love from the mother and spends it on his father's personality. I feel so happy when I think of you and other associate, even before I am there.

Dated: August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1976

Received your affectionate letter, we are bound by 'Yes' or 'No'. But we do not know where to apply 'Yes' or where to apply 'No'. This thing comes from the experience and experience comes from the experiment. When you

think of anything in the affirmative way, it is explained. Further on, if we speak 'no' for certain things then 'no' is explained. When the tension is caused detention goes. When the tension goes detention is there, which is not so heavy but still it is something. When both are gone that can be called the stage of Silence or the partial vacuum. There is no total vacuum, but we want to have as much as is possible. Total vacuum is God alone. When we merge in Divinity, the state of vacuum begins to dissolve itself, till it comes to the nearest. I think the subject is something other than that of your letter out it gives some knowledge of the Absolute.

Silence is a part of a few grains of spirituality and not the reality itself. If we want to explain it we can say that 'silence in silence', as I have written to you before, is nearer to God. That means silence is itself the seat on which Silence stands. It can be shown practically and that you can do well. Just have an idea and thing will start. Sahaj Marg is a practical method for Realization and by practice alone we can interpret silence. There are so many worms out side, which our naked eye cannot see but they are there. So, silence is there in abstract form, though we may not be able to see it. It can be seen by constant practice. This is other way of explaining the same thing.

"So, by the prayer, we go from out side noise to out side silence. By the cleaning we go from outside silence to inside silence. Internal darkness is an inside noise coming from the tension of the body and of the mind. Removing tension makes a vacuum". It does not sound well. By prayer we come nearer to our goal because we come in contact with the Being. There are two things, a goal of life and you yourself. Now, that yourself wants to merge in its Real Essence hence we derive benefits. If we remove all these things coming in, you will develop only hypnotic power. The same things give you Nectar if methodically done and the same proves harmful if it is not methodical. The method you know already.

Removing the tension means growing lighter, not creating the vacuum. That is a sort of change towards good. State of transparence is not a state of totally devoid of limitations, because there is something which allows you to peep into it.

Thoughts during meditation are just like the children playing on the road. When your attention is not towards thought, they are ineffective and are of no value. Thoughts do not disturb you, but you feel disturbed. The best way to get

rid of them, you have yourself said. They rise for the sake of fall. They are leaving their field. Waiting for the Divinity to come in, it is our system that we want to be away from all things not necessary. Point 'B' given in my book 'Efficacy of Raj Yoga' is the homeland of impressions. When the force of meditation tears off veil of the heart, these thoughts are attracted because of a little bit of vacuum, which is there. When thoughts arise you feel disturbance. So the thoughts do not meddle with you. You meddle with them.
